Acacia craspedocarpa - Leather-leaf Acacia	Planting	<i>Dense, rounded shrub to 8 feet tall by 5 feet wide with leathery 1 inch long broadly elliptical gray leaves (phyllodes) finely netted in green. The stems and new growth have coppery tones and the bark is somewhat fissured. The flowers in short, golden spikes (rods) appear in spring and various times through the year and are followed by attractive flat, rounded bright green seed pods. Very drought tolerant once established but also tolerates regular irrigation in well drained soils. Cold hardy to 15° F. Some sources in the desert southwest list it as a tree to 15-20 feet but it so slow growing here along the coast that this is hard to imagine. A interesting small tree or shrub for a low screen.</i>
Erysimum 'Pastel Patchwork' - Pastel Wallflower	Planting	<i>A perennial or subshrub to 18-24 inches tall with fragrant clusters of flowers of varying shades of soft yellow, beige and orange that change with the age of the long lasting flowers. Flowers from early spring through fall. Plant in full sun to light shade in moderately well drained soil and irrigate regularly. Hardy to 15-20° F. Prune lightly after first bloom to shape plant and promote added vigor. A great border plant or for use as a container specimen. Also very nice for use in flower arrangements.</i>
Protea 'Sylvia'	Planting	<i>A Protea exemia/susannae hybrid that has upright growth to 6-8 feet tall. It has medium to large flowers that are pink-red with bronze satiny glow and cream-yellow centers. Main flowering period is from November to February. Plant in full sun and water sparingly to regularly. It has good soil and great frost tolerance (to mid 20 ° F. We received this plant from Dennis Perry. The seedling originated in South Africa in 1977 but only was planted out extensively in South Africa as a floriculture crop since 1995 - it is now one of the most sought after proteas.</i>
